In the interest of keeping you up to date with the latest on what your support for the Ayalik Fund is doing ... during the summer months of 2018, we expect to be sending 20 Inuit youths on life-changing adventures:

- six youths to paddle in the NWT's Mackenzie Mountains, on the Ayalik Keele River Expedition
- two youths on a backpacking trek in the Rockies with Outward Bound
- one girl attending Outward Bound's *Indigenous Instructor Development Program* in the mountains of BC's interior
- four youths to sail on a tall-ship in Lake Ontario
- two youths to paddle down the Coppermine River as guides-in-training with a Canadian Canoe Foundation expedition
- two boys to a one-week camp at Gana River in the Mackenzie Mountains, NWT
- one boy to a 10-day canoe trip on Great Slave Lake
- two girls to a one-week canoe-camp near Yellowknife, NWT
- one girl to an on-the-land Northern Youth Forum held outside Yellowknife in September

More kids, from more communities, to more programs ... than ever before!

This year, the youths come from seven different communities, spread from Kugaaruk and Kugluktuk in the west, to Arviat in the southern Kivalliq, to Pond Inlet and Igloolik in north Baffin.
